APPLICATION DEADLINE - APRIL 13, 2026

 **Student Eligibility:**

- Current California high school sophomore or junior (10th or 11th grade)
- In good academic standing with a 2.5 GPA or higher
- Commitment to leadership and group participation

 **Application Requirements:**

- Current high school transcript
- Two signed letters recommendation letters (*one from a school official and one from a community member not related to the student*)
- Two brief essay responses (250 words max.)
- Supplemental Participation Forms
- Photo of applicant

 **Important Dates**

- **March 2, 2026:** Application opens
- **April 13, 2026:** Application deadline (*no late submissions*)
- **May 8, 2026:** Students notified
- **July 8-11, 2026:** Conference at CSUDH

All meals, lodging, conference materials and transportation during the conference are included at no cost to participants or their family. Transportation to and from CSUDH will be provided for participants residing outside of Los Angeles and Riverside counties from a designated central location. Participants will be supervised at all times and students may bring a small amount of spending money for extra snacks or souvenirs.
